

A dispatch from (Baltimore) says: A petition of Roscius Cowen and Murray, of the Baltimore and Ohio, for authority to issue \$650,000 additional, additional certificates has been signed by United States circuit Judge Goff for hearing on November 20th. The petition states that it is necessary to issue the certificates to pay for necessary improvements to the Pittsburg and Connellsville railroad, for which there is no money available. The certificates are to bear 5 per cent interest, and are to be payable as the court may direct. It is stated in the petition that J. P. Morgan & Co. and Speyer & Co., the New York bankers, who represent the holders of a majority of the Pittsburg and Connellsville bonds, are in favor of the issue, and have promised their aid. The certificates are to be a lien on the Burlington and Ohio and Pittsburg properties. It is understood the Baltimore and Ohio contemplates making many improvements to terminal facilities in Philadelphia, realizing the importance of this city as a freight center.
