

A Novel Law.
 A novel law may be found in chapter 114, page 206, private laws of 1907. It reads as follows:
 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
SECTION 1. That Charles H. Hats, of Yadkin county, be allowed to enter the State Hospital at Morganton for treatment.
SECTION 2. That all laws conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.
SECTION 3. That this act shall be in force from and after its ratification.
 Ratified the 11th day of March, A. D., 1907.
