**READY FOR LYNCHING.**

BRENNHAM, Tex., May 12.—When the section hands at No 24, near Lyons, on the Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe road, returned from work yesterday they found Mrs. B McDonough, wife of the boss, and her seven year old son weltering in their blood dead. All appearances indicate that the woman had been ravished and then beaten to death, and the boy also beaten to conceal the identity of the criminal. Two men, Frank Connors, white, flagman, and Frazier Davis, a negro, recently discharged by McDonough, are under arrest. Circumstantial evidence against the negro is very strong, his feet especially connecting him with the crime, fitting marks in the vicinity of the corpses perfectly. The negro will probably be lynched.
