### Railroad Commission.

Much business is being disposed of by this body. Yesterday in the case of the Carolina Roller Mills vs. Wilmington and Weldon Railroad Co. charging discrimination against Fayetteville in freight shipments to points in South Carolina, it was decided that the letter of explanation by defendant was satisfactory, and the case was dismissed.

In the case of Dickinson & Co. vs. Atlantic and North Carolina R. R. Co. charging a prepared rate by the company, it appeared that there was no cause for complaint.

In the case of Fauck vs. C. F. and Y. V. Railroad, claim for overcharge and damage was alleged, but it appeared to have been paid. Case dismissed.
