The tobacco trust bill is causing much comment. Here is a synopsis

It provides that poperson shall, af ter May 1st, operate any leaf tobacco warehouse without obtaining an an nual license. Any combination by any persons or corporations within the state with any association without the state which prevents, or in tends to prevent full and fair compe tition in the purchase of leaf tobacco. or which shall tend to suppress bidding for leaf tobacco sold in open market, or to cause sales at less prices than would otherwise be commanded, is declared against public policy fraudulent and unlawful No corporation as above described shall bid for leaf tobacco at any public sale or any warehouse under penalty of not less than \$100 nor more than \$5,000 fine, or imprisonment for not less than one nor more than three years, each days violation of the act constituting a separate offence.
