SWEPT TO THEIR DEATH

Immense Volume of Water Surge Over Deck of Ocean Liner, Carrying Several to Their Death and Injuring Many Others.

(By the Associated Press.) New York, Oct. 14.—Five lives are known to have been lost and more than thirty injured, one fatally, on the Cunard line steamer Campania, Wednesday, when a gigantic wave rolled over the steamer and swept across the deck, thick with stowage passengers...

The Campania was going under full headway Wednesday afternoon. There was nothing to indicate the approaching disaster, when suddenly the big steamer lurched to port and scooped up an enormous sea. The wave boarded the steamer about the ship on the port side and swept across the stowage deck, completely filling the space between that deck above and carrying everything with it. The steamer's side was buried so deep that passengers on the deck above the stowage were submerged to their waists as the immense volume of water rolled aft and then surged forward. All the cabin passengers on the upper deck succeeded in clinging to supports while the water surged around them, and were saved, but the unfortunates on the stowage deck found themselves utterly helpless.

Killed by Worry. Peoria, Ill., Oct. 14.—The Dougherty scandal has claimed another victim. Driven to desperation and nervous prostration by worry over the disclosures compromising his bank and fear of disastrous ruin, Nelson Barnham, a venerable stockholder in the Peoria National Bank, died suddenly last night. He was 79 years old and was worth half a million dollars.

Rockefeller Not going South. Cleveland, O., Oct. 14.—Mr. John D. Rockefeller has changed his plans regarding a trip South this week and will go to New York when he leaves here, probably Monday. The time of his leaving was scheduled for tomorrow, but as he is averse to travelling on Sunday, the party will not leave until Monday.

GERMANY ALARMED. Great Distrust Over the Recent Franco-British Alliance. (By the Associated Press.) Berlin, Oct. 14.—Disclosures in France of alleged British offers of alliance against Germany are so thoroughly believed here that a powerful naval league with its 600,000 members, and all apparatus of agitation is already moving for a new naval programme that shall further increase Germany's defensive resources against Great Britain. The popular distrust of Great Britain has naturally swollen to great proportions and semi-official denials in London cannot overcome convictions now formed that Germany had a narrow escape from war, in which although she would have been victorious on land, would have resulted in her being crushed at sea and damaged along the coast with a consequent destruction of her overseas commerce.

Disastrous Fire. Mount Sterling, Ky., Oct. 14.—Fire destroyed the Montgomery Blue Grass Seed Plant, a colored public school and Langston's grocery. The loss was \$80,000, one-third insured.

Athletic Event at Spencer. (Special to the Evening Times.) Spencer, Oct. 14.—Articles of agreement were signed here last night between Prof. Charles Leonard and Prof. Sam Morberger, of Indianapolis, to wrestle in Spencer on the night of October 20th. The two men are the greatest wrestlers of their class in the world, and the exhibition is expected to be one of the greatest anything ever seen in North Carolina. Leonard is the champion Greco-Roman wrestler of the world, and Morberger holds the championship in catch-as-catch-can for the great West.

DEATH OF SIR HENRY IRVING PERISHED IN THE FLAMES

Famous English Tragedian Died Suddenly at Bradford, England, Last Night After Having Played His Role of Becket

(By the Associated Press.) London, Oct. 14.—Sir Henry Irving died suddenly at Bradford, last night. The death of the distinguished actor was totally unexpected. He was engaged in a tour of the provinces, appearing nightly, and a few days ago spoke at a public meeting in advocacy of the movement for a municipal theatre. Sir Henry played as usual last night at Bradford and returned from the theatre to his hotel where he was seized with an attack of syncope, dying at 11:20 o'clock. Irving's last appearance was as Becket in Lord Tenison's play of that name. The Associated Press last night received the following telegram from Sir Henry Irving's manager, Bram Stoker: Very terrible news. Sir Henry Irving had an attack of syncope after returning from the theatre to the hotel to-night and died suddenly.

FINANCIALLY SOUND. Germania Bank, of New Orleans, in Prosperous Condition. New Orleans, Oct. 14.—The run on the Germania Bank was resumed this morning, but it is believed the excitement will pass with the day, as the impregnability of that institution is realized. Most of those who are withdrawing are the poorer classes, who have not taken the trouble to investigate the story upon which the run is grounded. The clearing house commission investigating the bank's affairs and finds, if called upon to do so, it could pay every depositor every cent due and have left for distribution among stockholders a surplus of \$898,908.

International Automobile Race. (By the Associated Press.) New York, Oct. 14.—The international automobile race for the Vanderbilt cup started at 6 o'clock on the Minoela, Long Island, course. Jenatry in Robert Graves' German 120 horse-power car was the first to start, followed quickly by eighteen others at one minute intervals. The course 28.3 miles around is to be covered ten times, making a total distance of 283 miles. Hemeny, driving a French machine, is the winner of the automobile race.

General McGlashan Ill. (By the Associated Press.) Savannah, Ga., Oct. 14.—General McGlashan, commanding the Georgia division, United Confederate Veterans, was stricken with paralysis while attempting to arise yesterday morning from a sick bed. His entire left side was affected and it is feared his illness will preclude his participation in the reunion exercises at Macon, November 9th and 10th.

Famine Causes Riot. (By the Associated Press.) Seville, Spain, Oct. 14.—Over a thousand farm laborers, made desperate by the existing famine, invaded the market place at Ecija near here, seized the entire stock of food and money, destroyed the market and threw the town into a panic. The authorities hastily applied for military relief.

Four Surveyors Drowned. (By the Associated Press.) Winnipeg, Manitoba, Oct. 14.—Four men belonging to a party of six Grand Trunk Pacific surveyors, were drowned yesterday in the Winnipeg river near Kemera, by the upsetting of their canoe.

Official Ending of War. Washington, Oct. 14.—The Emperors of Russia and Japan this morning signed the peace treaty, thus officially ending the war.
