21 BODIES HAVE BEEN RECOVERED.

(By the Associated Press.) Charleston, W. Va., Feb. 11.—Twenty-one bodies have been recovered from the Park mine in Fayette county. It is supposed that only one body remains to be recovered, making the total fatalities twenty-two.
