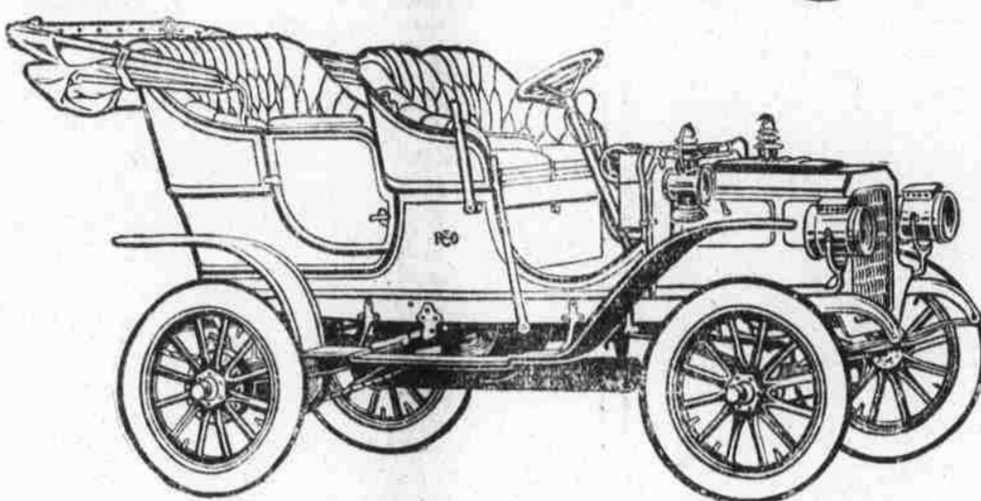

Besides the votes issued on subscriptions, there is a coupon printed in each issue of The Raleigh Times, which, when cut out, name filled in, and brought or sent to the Contest Department of The Raleigh Times, Raleigh, N. C., will count as one vote. These ballots are good for one week only, and must be polled before the expiration of the date printed on each one. The votes issued on subscriptions are good until the end of the contest, December 29.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Cash must accompany all subscriptions where votes are to be issued.
2. Persons paying for The Evening Times prior to November 12 are NOT entitled to votes in this contest.
3. When votes are desired they should be asked for at the time of paying for the subscription. Votes will not be issued on presented receipts.
4. Candidates and others who send in orders should state whether the subscriptions are new or old, whether to be delivered by carrier or by mail, and whether votes are to be polled or returned to the subscriber.
