During the administration of Franklin Pierce, Brigham Young, desire to equip themthe Mormon chief, denied the authority of the United States government, and secure, as he thought, in the wilds of Utah, he defied the military authorities.

'Can't you make Brigham Young behave?' the president asked Albert Sidney Johnson, one of the best soldiers that ever lived.

"General Johnson said he could. and we started out from Fort Leavenworth, Kan., for the Mormon settlement in Utah, 1,600 miles away We were gone two years. There wasn't much war to it. It was what you might call a 'leg war.' Brigham Young gave up as quick as we got

After this Mr. Smith retired to private life, and lived in peace until the Civil War broke out.

"I'm the original secessionist," said Mr. Smith, "and I haven't been reconstructed vet. I believe just as much in states' rights as I did before the war. I made the first Confederate flag. I designed the "Stars and Bara" that we fought under four years, Reconstructed? Huh-not by a d-n sight!

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
