

PUBLIC ACTS.

1. An act directing in what manner the laws of our sister States shall be received in evidence in this State. [This act directs that the Secretary of State shall give when required a certified copy of any law of any particular State from the records in his office, which copy shall be received as evidence of the law itself.]

Power of Attorney, Bills of Sale and Deeds of Gift. [Extends the provisions of the act for two years.]

52. Concerning the Clubfoot and Harlow's Creek Canal Company. [The State is authorized to subscribe \$5000 more for this work, when a like sum shall be subscribed by individuals.]

Constables in the counties of Warren, Northampton and Brunswick, so far as relates to the county of Ashe.

80. To repeal the 7th section of an act, passed in 1822, authorizing certain counties therein named, to appoint a committee of Finance, so far as respects the county of Anson.
