2. Ten minutes shall be allowed for opening and closing the mail at all offices where no particular time is specified.

3. For every thirty minutes delay (anavoidable accidents excepted) in arriving after the time prescribed in any contract, the contractor shall forfeit one dollar; and if the delay continue until the departure of any depending mail, whereby the mails destined for such depending mail lose a trip, a forfeiture of double the amount allowed for carrying the mail one trip shall be incurred, unless it shall be made to appear that the delay was occasioned by unavoidable accident; in which case the amount of pay for a trip will, in all cases, be forfeited and retained.

4. Persons making proposals, are desired to state their prices by the year.-Those who contract will receive their pay quarterly-in the months of February, May, August and November, one wonth after the expiration of each quarter.

5. No other than a free white person shall be employed to carry the mail.

6. Where the proposer intends to convey the mail in the body of a stage carririage, he is desired to state it in his proposals; and the stage must be of sufficient size to conveniently convey seven passengers.

7. The Post Master General reserves to himself the right of declaring any contract at an end whenever one failure happens which amounts to the loss of a trip.

8. The distances stated are such as Leave Bryant's K Roads every other thank heen communicated to this office,
