NOTES.

1. The Post Master General may expedite the Mails, and after the times for arrival and departure, at any time during the continuance of the contract, he paying an adequate compensation for any extra expense that may be occasioned thereby.

2. Ten minutes shall be allowed for opening and closing the mail at all offices where no particular time is specified.

3. For every thirty minutes delay (onavoidable accidents excepted) in arriving after the time prescribed in any contract, the contractor shall forfeit one dollar; and if the delay continue until the departure of any depending mail, whereby the mails destined for such depending mail lose a trip, a forfeiture of double the amount allowed for carrying the mail one trip shall be incurred, unless it shall be made to appear that the delay was occasioned by unavoidable accident; in which case the amount of pay for a trip will, in all cases, be forfeited and retained.

4. Persons making proposals, are desired to state their prices by the year. Those who contract will receive their pay quarterly-in the months of February, May, August and November, one nonth after the expiration of each quar;

5. No other than a free while person shall be employed to carry the mail.

6. Where the propo er intends to convey the mail in the body of a stage carririage, he is desired to state it in his proposals; and the stage must be of sufficient size to conveniently convey seven pas-

7. The Post Master General reserves o himself the right of declaring any contract at an end whenever one failure happens which amounts to the loss of a trip.

8. The distances stated are such as have been communicated to this office. and some of them are doubtless incorrect: on this subject the contractor must inform himself; no alteration will be made in the pay on account of any error in this respect.

9. Proposals for the routes in Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, and Louisiana, are to be addressed to the Postmaster General, at Huntsville, where an agent will attend and give provisional accept-

Proposals for routes in South-Carolina and Georgia are to be addressed to Columbia, S. C.
