





Wil you please te i me why the Farmers Alliance, composed of tobacco and cot ton growers could not have accomp lisbed all that will be accomplished by this new organization! Can two or gan s tion - wield more influence and exert more power than one strong. thoroughly organized one! The Alli ance is proader in its conception of the situation this new association and would enlist many hearty sym pathis re and supporters who are not specially topacco or cotton raisers, but wh) w uld glidly embrace a chance of helping to down the trusts that are today so grievously oppressing all classes of producers and consumers

I was talking with a gentle nan o intelligence and experience today, and he said, "Calk about liberty and free dom in this country-thousands do no know anything about it " I believ. the truth will bear putting it stronger There are thousands in our land who dare not claim the time that God has given them. I'n+ truste and mon police ciccate the hours of labor, the price of products, the terms of service and sometimes wnether there shall be any service at all or not. What is the final outcome o' a monopoly cursed land and government Concentration of wealth, discrimination in legislation, the substitu ion of an oligarchy for the republic; disr spect for the laws of the land, issues and hatred for our National rul-rs and contempt for minor officials; and, lastly, we shall see conditions favorable for the d vel opment of anarchism and communism The decline of morality, virtue and patriotism must inevitably follow such conditions. Religion will cease to restrain men from wrong and home will lose its sweetness in the same pro Dortion. I would not be pessimistic in my views, but can it be that there is a similarity in the ratios of the growth of the trust power and the increase of crime, suicide, divorce, lynching, mur der, vagrancy, &o.! I see from recent quotations that many things used by o r farmers have ad vanced from 1 to 200 per cent., such as iron, steel and farming tools. Now, if such things advance and tobacco and other farm products do not in equal ratio, how long before the farmer will be in a worse condition than he is now? I have visited the homes of a good many people in the tobacco counties, Person, Osswell, Rockingham, Alamance and Guilford during the last year Most of them have plenty to eat, but home comforts and educa- bined. tional training are to a great extent lacking Mr Eintor, tell us how these things are to be remedied without more money in the farmers' pockets, and you will confer a favor upon a large class of people.
