SCHOOL LAW

An Act to Make School Attendance Compulsory--All Children, Age 8 to 12. School Four Months.

(Substitute for.) The Section 5. county board of education in each county shall appoint and remove at will an attendance officer in each township enforce the provisions this act. It shall be the duty of the school committe or district to furnish each superintendent, principal, or teacher in charge of each school, and to furnish also the attendance officer of each township and the county superintendent, with an accurate school census of each school district king, Ahab. Upon the willful or neglegent failure of any principal or teacher in charge of any school to comply with the provisions of this section, the county superintendent shall deduct from his or her salary for the current month the sum of five dollars before approving the voucher therefor.
