Make no mistake, said this grave man of affairs to the boys at Princeton: "Here was a most distinguished man, a great man, a useful man, who became distinguished, great and useful because had and retained unimpaired, qualities of heart which I fear university students sometimes feel like keeping in the background or abandoning."
