GENERAL NEWS.

—Dr. L. R. Scarborough, of Fort Worth, Texas, has accepted the position of director general of the campaign to be put on by Southern Baptists to raise \$75,000,000. The objects to which the campaign funds will be appropriated are: Christian education, foreign missions, home missions, State missions, ministerial relief, hospital and the national memorial.

—Rev. Samuel M. Anderson, a negro preacher, was killed by lightning Sunday while reading the Scripture in a church near Kings Mountain. The "same bolt" of lightning, it was said, killed Horace Ware, a white boy, four miles away and destroyed a barn.

—A resolution expressing organized labor's disapproval of wartime prohibition and strongly urging that 2 3-4 per cent beer be exempt from the provisions of the eighteenth amendment to the constitution and from the wartime prohibition measure which goes into effect July 1, was adopted Wednesday, by the reconstruction convention of the American Federation of Labor in session at Atlantic City, N. J. The resolution will be sent to the President and Congress.

**TOO BANY PIGS CAUSED
DEFEAT OF THE FATHERLAND**

Ludendorff maintains it was the revolutionary spirit of the German soldiers that caused Germany's defeat. Admiral Beatty says it was the British Navy, General Pershing thinks it was the American army, while armchair strategists declare it was Foch's great offensive.

But, really, Germany was defeated because she had too many pigs, says Doctor M. Hindede, the distinguished Danish vegetarian.

The German pig betrayed the Fatherland and contributed more to the downfall of Germany than the Allies' blockade.

At the outbreak of war, the food situation was more serious in Denmark than in Germany. Denmark, however, reduced the number of her pigs and cattle, thereby restricting the consumption of cereals in the country.

Germany, on the other hand, instead of reducing the number of her pigs and cattle, forbade the slaughtering of cattle under seven years old and of pigs less than sixty kilos in weight. No restrictions were put on feeding them with cereals.

By the spring of 1915 there was scarcely a potato left in Germany.

So Germany starved while Denmark thrived, and the pigs that were intended to save the Fatherland ate the food so urgently needed by her population.

That is why Germany lost the war.
