

For cauning purposes-Sow seed in seed beds in April for plants to but into garden in June-Stone.

Egg Plant. For the summer crop-Sow seed n hotbeds in February for plants to put into garden as soon as danger of frost is over-New York Purple.

Celery. For the fall crop-Sow seed in seed beds in April and May for plants to put into garden July 15 to August 15—Self blanching, white plume. For the winter crop-Sow seed in seed beds in April for plants to put

into the garden August 1 to 15th-

Collards.

Giant pascal.

For the fall and winter crop-Sow seed in seed beds in April and May for plants to put into garden in June and July to mature in November-North Carolina short stem, Georgia. Cabbage.

For the spring crop-Sow seed of Charleston Wakefield in seed beds in September for plants to put into garden in November for heads in

For the summer crop-Sow seed of Charleston Wakefield in hotbeds in January for plants to put into garden in March for heads in June

and July. For the fall crop-Sow seed of Henderson's succession, Indian summer, flat Dutch, drumhead, or savoy in seed beds June 1 to 15 for plants to put into garden August 1 to 10 for heads in October.


