ATTENTION CALLED TO, CITY ORDINANCE

Mayor T. G. Stem Calls Attention to
The Following Ordinance Which Is Not Being Enforced.

Be It Ordained By The Board of Commissioners of Oxford: That all motor vehicles moving along Gilliam Street in a Northerly direction and toward Williamsboro Street in the town of Oxford on approaching Williamsboro Street shall be brought to a complete stop before entering said Williamsboro Street at a point 30 feet from Williamsboro Street.

That all motor vehicles moving along Broad Street in a Southerly direction and toward Hillsboro Street in the town of Oxford on approaching Hillsboro Street shall be brought to a complete stop before entering said Hillsboro Street at a point 30 feet from Hillsboro Street.

That all motor vehicles moving in a Southerly direction along Broad Street in the Town of Oxford on approaching McClanahan Street shall be brought to a complete stop on the North side of the intersection of said streets 30 feet from the corner.

Any driver of any motor vehicle violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined \$10.00. Adopted May 11th, 1920.

Boys Who Plan to Make It Their Life
Work Should Know and Appreciate Its Value.

In a few years the entire system of communication throughout the world may be transformed by wireless electricity, and it is important that boys should be able to take their part in it. The amateur wireless station is a great educator and gives the boys who equip and operate it an excellent education in the wonderful new science.

When the call came for wireless men for the great war the amateur operators were able to take a prominent part. Thousands of boys who had taught themselves how to build stations and run them were able to take important positions in wireless stations at sea and on shore. No other country had so vast an army of self-taught wireless operators to call on. Many of the boys who had taught themselves all they knew of the science rose to occupy important positions. It is not generally known that it was an amateur wireless man who was chosen to fly across the Atlantic on the NC-4 on her famous flight—Boys' Life.

HAS BOTH MEMORY AND SCAR

Two Excellent Reasons Why One Man Will Remember That He Was Kicked by a Mule.

A kick from a mule is guaranteed to make just about as much impression on the memory as it does on the anatomy. Yet Clyde D. Jarvis has made sure that he will not forget the kick he received from a Missouri beast of burden for the rest of his natural life.
