Insurance Rates On Autos Are To Be Cut In State

Increase in Collision Rates on Certain Vehicles Also Proposed

Approval has been given to the filing of the North Carolina Fire Insurance Rating Bureau of proposed changes in rates on fire, theft, collision and comprehensive automobile coverage as amended. Commissioner of Insurance Waldo C. Cheek announced today. The filing as proposed provided for reductions in the following classes: private passenger cars, comprehensive, fire and theft; commercial long hauling, comprehensive, fire and theft; intermediate hauling, comprehensive, fire and theft; increases in collision rates on private passenger cars, commercial long hauling, commercial intermediate hauling and commercial long distance hauling were proposed. The filing also proposed the re-symboling of pre-1942 automobiles in the state so as to increase collision premium rates on old cars. The symbols as set forth in the automobile insurance manual depend on the factory-advised price of the car. The more expensive cars receive a lower letter in the alpha-

bet. Letters range from A (for early models listed at around \$700 when new) to P (for cars priced at around \$5,500). The lower the symbol in the alphabet, the greater the amount of the annual insurance premium.

It was proposed that all pre-1942 cars have the same symbols as those placed on comparable 1942 models for collision insurance. However, no change of more than two symbols would be made.

A public hearing was held by the Department of Insurance on September 21, 1949, to consider these proposals.

It was brought out at the hearing that the pre-war private passenger cars are not paying their part of the losses on collision coverage. At the close of the hearing the commissioner requested additional statistics to be filed with the department for justification of this claim.

A thorough study of the facts brought out at the public hearing has resulted in approval of the filing with respect to fire, theft and comprehensive, resulting in a considerable overall reduction to policyholders.

With respect to the collision filing and on the basis of a study by the Insurance Department of information furnished by the North Carolina Fire Insurance Rating Bureau, the department has approved their filing for changes in collision rates, resulting in an overall reduction at an estimated saving of \$527,797.

The effective date of this filing will be contained in the new automobile manual which is now in the hands of the printers and which will be distributed by the North Carolina Fire Insurance Rating Bureau to the agents and companies just as soon as it has been received.

Sequoia Potatoes In Strong Demand

Growers of certified Sequoia potato seed in Avery County are continuing to find a good market for their product in Tennessee, Virginia and the two Carolinas, reports H. R. Niswonger, in charge of horticulture extension at State College.

In fact, says Niswonger, the growers are unable to meet the demand for their product. They recently sold 7,000 bags of seed potatoes in the four states, and could have sold another 7,000 bags if the potatoes had been available.

Some 15 or more new growers will produce certified seed of this variety in 1950.

A grower in the Vale community, John Calhoun, this year tried the Essex variety, which was developed by the New York Experiment Station for resistance to late blight. He expects to harvest around 500 bushels. Calhoun brought 34 bushels of certified Essex seed in 1948 and produced enough seed to plant 1.7 acres this year.

The Vale farmer also is growing 10 acres of Sequoias and expects to harvest around 20,000 bushels of this variety this year. He is building a new seed house.
