TOWN ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, WE THE COMMISSIONERS of the town of Salisbury, deem it of the utmost importance that a sufficient Police and Patrol force be organized within said town.

Therefore be it ordained, That in accordance with Sec. 22d of the charter of the Yown of Salisbury, an enrollment of all free white male inhabitants from the age of 18 and upwards, within the corporate limits of said town, shall take place at the Town Hall on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, the 12th. 13th and 14th instants, commencing at 9 A. M.. and closing at 5 P. M , each day.

Be it further ordained, That all free white male inhabitants who fail to earoll their names, within the time on the days named shall be fined the sum of Ten Dollars and be enrolled for double duty.

Be it further ordained, That the Intendant of Pofice and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners attend at the Town Hall, each day at the hours named to euroll the names. THOS. C. McN EELY. euroll the names. C. B. C.
