**FROM THE TELEGRAPH.**

Prince Tuan and Gen. Tung Foh Hsiang are reported to be planning a new rebellion in China.

The American Federation of Catholic Societies, in session at Cincinnati, voted to admit women to membership.

Gen. Yung Lee, a noted anti-foreigner leader in China, has been awarded the two-eyed peacock feather—a high distinction.

Count von Kanitz, the German agrarian leader, speaking in the Reichstag, said that American predominance in commerce is a danger to Europe.

Heavy storms on the English coast are claiming many victims. A Belgian fishing boat was sunk yesterday and 14 persons drowned.

The Review Knitting Mills and contents, at Tarboro, N. C., were burned yesterday. The mills and stock were valued at \$55,000; insurance, \$31,000.

At Paris, Tenn., yesterday, S. J. Man Mitchell, a negro teacher, shot and fatally wounded his wife and then set fire to the house. The negro took refuge in a cabin, where he was located by City Marshal Mills, who was fired upon as he entered the place. Mills returned the fire, killing the negro. Meanwhile the fire at Mitchell's house was extinguished and the woman rescued, but she will die.

Got Three Thieves Out of Four.  
The Greensboro Record says: A telegram was received from High Point this morning by Chief of Police W. A. Scott telling him to look out for and arrest four negroes charged with breaking into a store last night at High Point and stealing some shoes, caps, etc.

Mr. Scott began a search immediately and he and Officer Barne went out to the coal chute and met an incoming freight train, which stopped there to coal the engine.

As the train slacked its speed the four negroes, who beat a ride here from High Point, jumped off, and three of them were nabbed by the officers, who brought them down street and committed them to jail.

The fourth man was some distance from the officers when the train stopped, and he hit the grill and escaped capture.

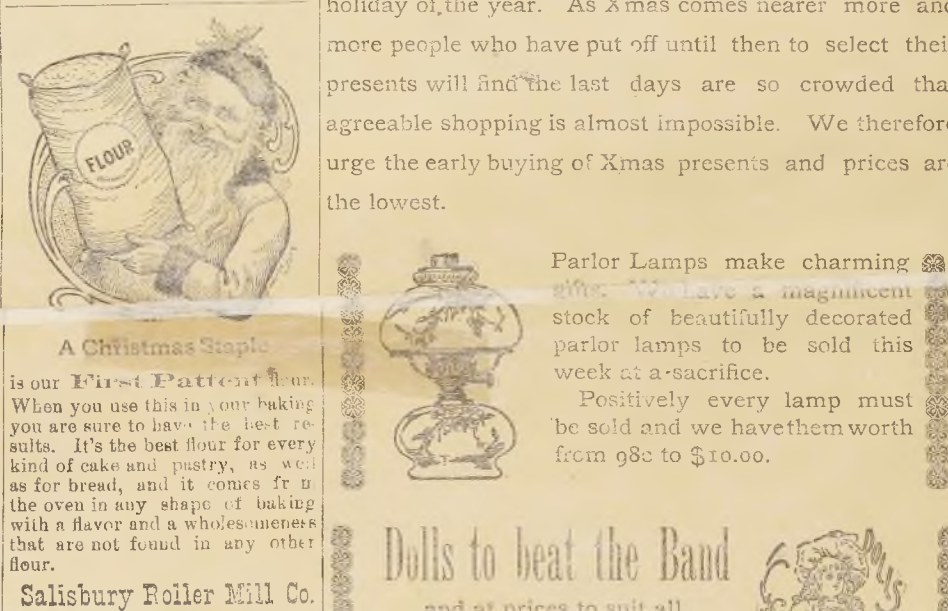

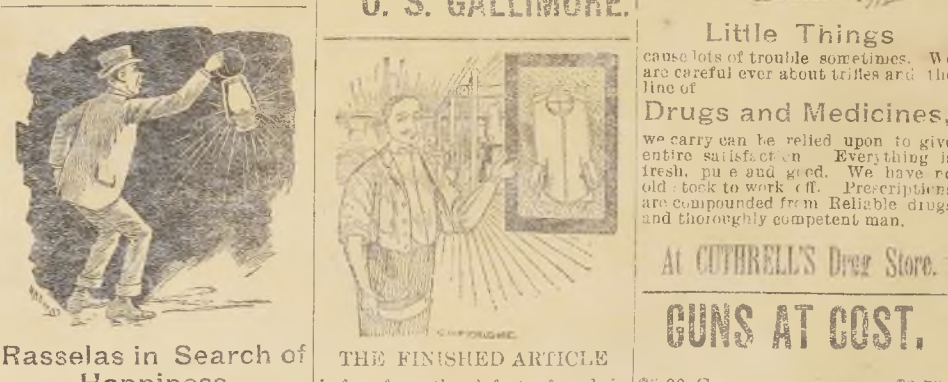
