Our stock of money in circulation is \$2,175,387,277 for a population estimated at 77,754,000. The coin, including bullion, in th Treasury aggregrates \$1,734,861,-774, which sum, with \$748,285,-518 of United States notes and bank notes, makes a grand total of \$2,483,147,292.
