CREAM OF THE TELEGRAPH.

Collected Down, and Condensed for Index Readers.

London, Nov. 29.—The War Office received the following, dated Cape Town, November 28, 11:45 p. m.: "General Lord Methuen sends following from Modder river today: We reconnoitered at 5 a. m. the enemy's position on Modder river. They were found strongly entrenched and concealed, with no means of outflanking them, as the river was full. The action commenced at 5:30 a. m. The Grenadiers on the right, and the Ninth brigade on the left, attacked their position, supported by artillery. They found confronting the whole Boer force of 8,000 men, with two large guns and four Krupp. The naval brigade rendered great assistance from the railway. After desperate fighting for ten hours without food or water in the
