

It is more than probable that Senator Call, of Florida, will be given his seat. Fleming declared the election unconstitutional and appointed ex-Congressman Davidson to the place. Senator Hoar, of Massachusetts, has a similar opinion, and it was upon his motion that Mr. Call was allowed to take the oath of office pending the decision of the contest.

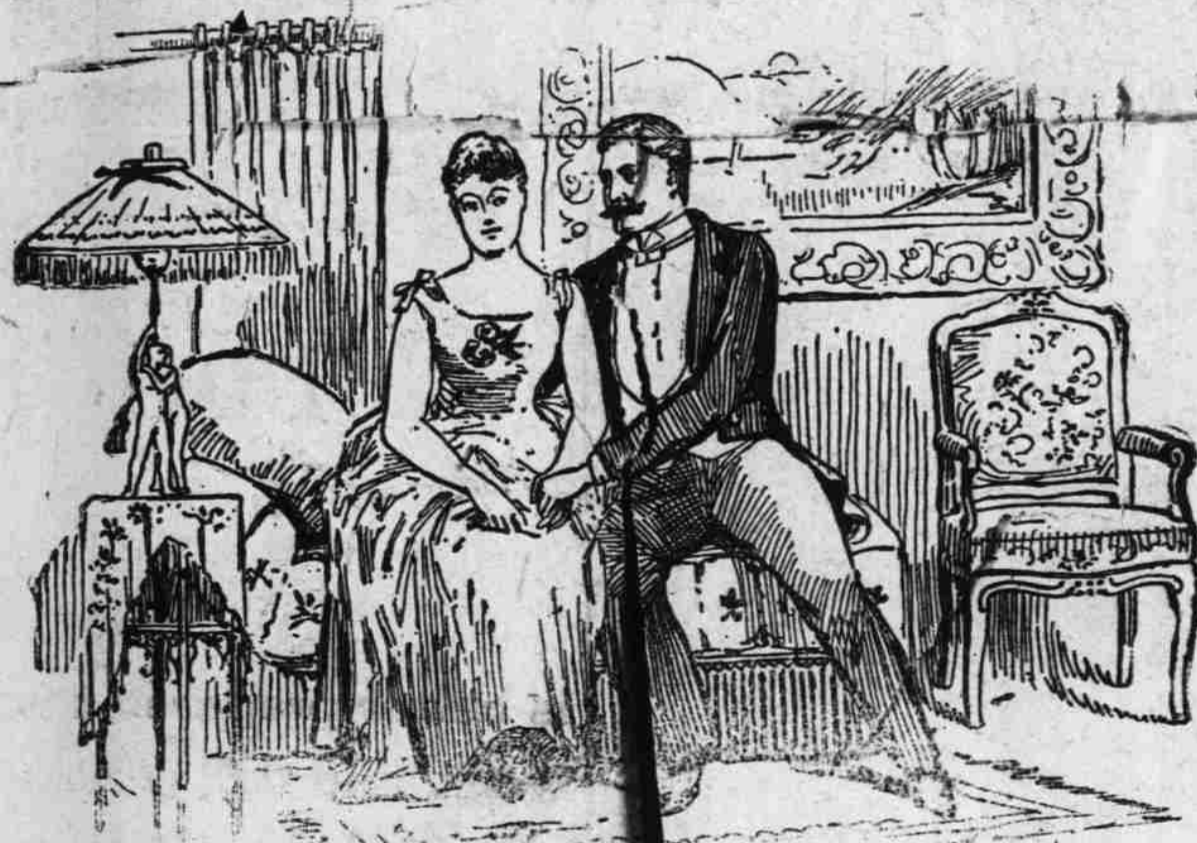
