The General Assembly of North

Carolina do enact: Section 1. That for the purpose of grading, building and constructing of gravel, soil, top soil or other material, and otherwise improving and maintaining the public roads of Alexander County and erect the necessary br dges, the board of commissioners of said county is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to issue bonds of the said county to an amount not exceed ing one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) in deinterest from the date thereof not exceeding the rate of five per cent per annum, with interest coupons attached, payable emi-annually at such time and ace as may be directed by said ard of commissioners, such ds to be of such form and

Sec. 5. That said taxes, when collected, shall be kept separate of commissioners for the county and apart from the other taxes, and shall be used only for the purpose of which they were collected.
