President-Elect Marches in a Parade and Afterwards Re- ceives Honors. Feb. 11.—President- elect Woodrow Wilson landed here at 3 o'clock this afternoon. He was met by a large number of the citizens and was enthusiastically received by the entire city. He is to be until Saturday.
