

# METHODIST TO MEET JUNE 27

Founding of Methodism To Be Celebrated At Two-Day Session In Virginia

## HAS A RICH HERITAGE

South Hill, Va., June 13.—Methodists of upper North Carolina and lower Virginia will be interested to learn of plans now rapidly shaping for the celebration on June 27 and 28 of the founding of Methodism.

More than 100 years ago Methodist preachers were operating in these sections. "Brunswick Circuit" included the large territory between Petersburg south into North Carolina was one of the most fruitful fields for this movement. No section of this great country can claim a richer heritage in this great cause. The center of this radiating influence was old "Salem Chapel."

Science was old of the present town in the middle south of the Virginia Conference in this old annual conference during a period of nine years, a proud record which no other country church and probably few churches in America can boast. Asbury referred to it as "the best country church in Virginia."

A granite marker with bronze tablet is being placed on the site of this old church and will be unveiled during the celebration. Every effort is being made to make this the outstanding celebration of this section of North Carolina and Virginia. Several of the bishops of the two larger branches of Methodism have accepted places on the program along with some outstanding characters in other walks in life. A large painting of the equestrian Asbury to form the back stage piece will be unveiled in the march of the pioneers.

It was in this community that historical characters like McKenney, John Easter, Henry Ogburn and John Ogburn who established Methodism in Kentucky) were cradled. Already many indications are coming in from long distances of people who will come for this outstanding event. The Methodist of the northern part of North Carolina are especially invited to attend and visit the scenes from which sprang the influences that afterwards established Methodism in North Carolina.

Child Welfare Survey Being Made In Warren County

A State-wide Child Welfare Survey of North Carolina, sponsored by the North Carolina Department of the American Legion and the American Legion Auxiliary, started Friday, May 25, under the direction of Mrs. W. R. Absher, State Department President of the American Legion Auxiliary. The survey is being conducted from the office of the State Supervisor, Miss Rachel Payne Sugg, North Wilkesboro. J. R. Palmer of Macon is canvasser for Warren county.

Waters' wages in each county are being paid by the E. R. A. funds. The survey has a four-fold purpose and is expected to result in the recording of the status of every needy, blind, deaf, or crippled child in the State; the listing of every World War veteran and World War orphan. The needy children of veterans will be recorded so that those eligible to receive help from the Legion's National Child Welfare Endowment fund of more than \$5,000 may be determined. "There are many North Carolina children entitled to relief from this source, and a few are receiving it," Mrs. Absher states. Next, the survey will list every needy orphan and any other child in need to the cases may be brought to the attention of the relief agencies.

Every blind and deaf child now not receiving adequate care will be listed, as will adult blind persons, and all crippled children and other persons who need industrial rehabilitation will be noted.

The result of the survey will be studied and followed up by State and National Agencies, Joint Welfare Committee of the Legion and Auxiliary Child Welfare Committee of local units and posts, and other welfare agencies. To secure the necessary help for the county, the survey must be as complete as possible, Mrs. Absher said.

Yesterday J. R. Palmer made the following statement: "In the Child Welfare Survey we desire that every one who knows of any child that should be included in the census of veterans' orphans, physically handicapped, or other underprivileged children, please notify me personally or by mail. It is very essential that we have the whole-hearted cooperation of all civic organizations. If the survey is to be a success in Warren county."

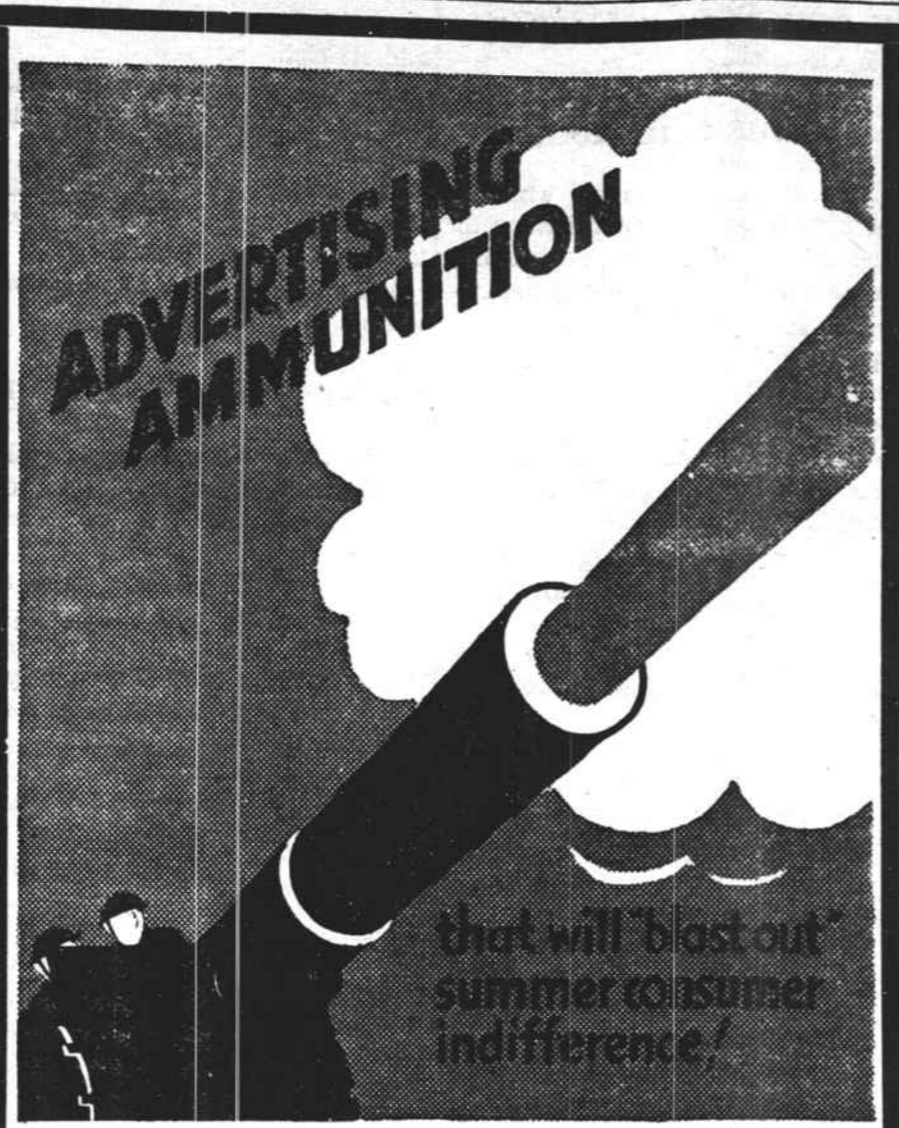

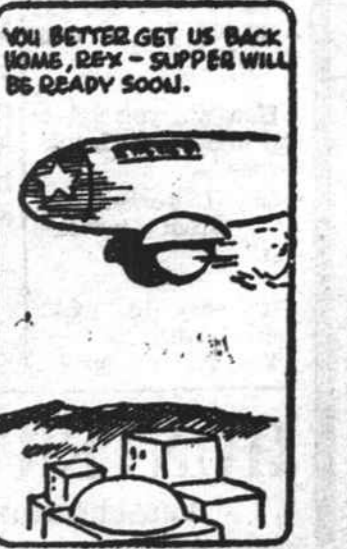
