Pursuant to a judgment entered in above entitled civil action on the 9th day of July, 1934, in the Superior Court of said County by the Clerk, I will on the 3rd day of September, 1934, at 12 o'clock M., at the County Courthouse door in said County sell at public auction to the highest bidder therefor the following described lands, situated in said county and state in Sandy Creek Township, comprising 121 acres, more or less, and bounded and described as follows:

"All that certain lot, tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty-one (121) acres, more or less, located, lying and being in Sandy Creek Township, County of Warren, and State of North Carolina, being bounded on the north by the lands of Dr. Gill; East by the lands of Foster et als; south by the lands of Chas.
