Tourists Thank Sheriff For Courteous Treatment

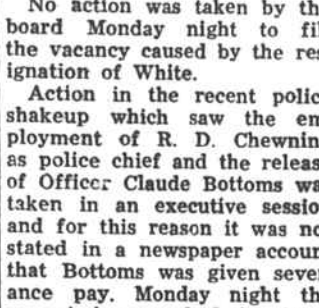
