STATEMENT OF RESULT OF THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN THE TOWN OF NORLINA, NORTH CAROLINA, ON JANUARY 8, 1963. At a special bond election held in the Town of Norlina, North Carolina, on January 8, 1963, 365 voters were registered and qualified to vote. At said election 213 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the Town of Norlina to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$165,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of said Town for the purpose of providing funds with any other available funds, for constructing a sanitary sewer system for said Town, including the acquisition and construction of sewage collection, treatment and disposal facilities and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 31 votes were cast against said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.
