

IS an agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Its objective is to provide protection not available through commercial companies, at low cost to farmers against crop losses resulting from unavoidable loss of tobacco and cotton production due to insects, disease, drought, excessive rain, flood, hail, wind, frost, freeze, cool weather, fire, lightning, snow, hurricane, tornado and any other unavoidable loss due to adverse weather conditions.

Partial Crop Loss Justifies A Claim

Your entire crop does not have to be destroyed before you can collect. In fact MOST claims are paid in cases where the insured made SOME tobacco or cotton, but less than his insured guarantee per acre.

Poor Quality Crops Due To Damage

by bad weather justifies a claim, too! Provisions of the F. C. I. C. policy can protect you against losses in years when your crop brings a very low price on the market because of poor quality caused by weather damage.

File Notice Of Claim With Local Office

Any time during the growing season that the insured thinks his tobacco or cotton crop is so nearly destroyed that he does not wish to further care for it or wants to put the acreage to other use, he should report this damage to the F. C. I. C. County Office or F. C. I. C. Representative by card, telephone call or personal visit. An adjuster will inspect his crop immediately.
