The Golden Belt Dairy Herd Improvement Association, which jointly serves Vance and Warren Counties made some unusually fine production records which were announced at their recent annual meeting. In the picture above you see Hal Paschall (right), retiring president, presenting production certificates to (l. to r.) Walter J. Bender, Alvis Fleming, Bill Craft, and Fred Newton.

A cow on the Alvis Fleming Farm, Littleton, produced during a 305-day period 20,470 pounds milk and 600 receive a plaque for the highest producer in the association. A cow on the Fred Newton Farm in Vance County received the award for the cow producing the highest butterfat—613 pounds—over a 305-day period.

Alvis Fleming also was awarded a plaque for the highest herd production of 14,164 pounds milk per cow and averaged 481 pounds butterfat. The herd of Fred Newton averaged 510 pounds butterfat and others averaging over 400 pounds butterfat per cow were Bill Craft and Walter J. Bender.
