#### Bank Earnings

W. W. Shaw, president of the Peoples Bank and Trust Company, has reported that net operating earnings for the first nine months of the year rose to a record \$499,908.38 or \$2.17 per share - up 39.3% from the \$358,809.69, or \$1.56 per share, earned in the same period of 1966.

Assets, deposits and loans also reached levels substantially above those of a year ago. Deposits rose to \$73,788,341.88 from \$69,274,937.35 as of September 30, 1966, an increase of 6.5%. Loans rose from \$48,097,430.87 to \$49,093,410.16, an increase of 2.1%.

Per-share figures for both years are based on 230,200 shares outstanding.

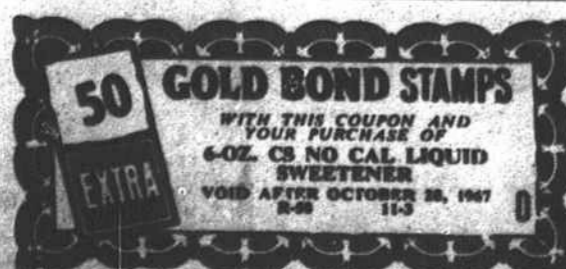
