

## Wake Team Hands Jackets Dual Loss

Vaiden Whitley won a basketball double-header over Warrenton Friday night on the Yellow Jackets home court. In the opener, the Jacket jayvee squad evened its record against Vaiden Whitley at 1-1 with a 55-52 loss to the visitors. Then in the nightcap the boys varsity team from Vaiden Whitley rallied in the final period of play to hand John Graham a 61-59 defeat. The Lady Jackets did not see action Friday night.

### Jayvee Game

Vaiden Whitley jumped to an early 32-25 lead over the Jackets as first half action ended.

At the start of second half play the Jackets outdistanced the visitors, 17-10, to go into final period play.

Each team scored 13 points in the fourth quarter to give Vaiden Whitley the three-point win.
