charge, he was ordered to jail for six months, suspended for five years on the condition that he pay \$25 each week for use of his minor child, and pay court costs.

Roy Lee Bobbitt, assault on female, ordered to jail for six months suspended for three years on the condition that he keep the peace toward his wife and pay fine of \$50 and court costs.
