Project Begins

LITTLETON — Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Co. has begun a construction project to increase telephone service capabilities along US 158 east of Littleton.

The area has several residential subdivisions including the Roanoke Shores Development on Lake Gaston. The additional facilities should provide service to the area's residential and commercial subscribers for the next 10 years.

Approximately 15,000 feet of 600 pair aerial cable is being placed along the route at a cost of \$67,000.

Presently, 344 telephone lines are working in the area. By October, 1987, 953 lines are expected to be in use.

Richard Barnes, Jr., manager for Carolina Telephone in Littleton, said the new cable is being placed aerially instead of underground in order to avoid conflict with highway work being performed by the state highway department.

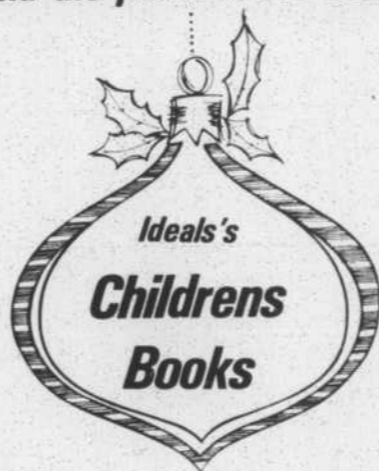
