The federal minimum mum wage generally apwage rises to \$3.10 an hour, plies to all other businesses with four or more employ-

Before today's change, the federal minimum wage was \$2.90 an hour. It will rise to \$3.35 in 1981.

The state's minimum wage is scheduled to rise to \$2 90 an hour this July 1.
