

**Session Set For Moms, Tots**

The Adolescent Health Care Program at HealthCo is sponsoring a Moms and Tots session at the HealthCo Annex on March 28 at 2 p. m. The session is being offered to teenage mothers to provide them with information and to let them ask questions about health care issues for their children.

Topics which will be discussed include: how to recognize when your baby is not well and what to do, reading a thermometer and the best ways to take your child's temperature, good tips for meeting the nutritional needs of your youngster and dental health information including how to cope with teething problems. The session is free and free snacks for both moms and their youngsters will be provided.

Mothers should feel free to bring their children if they do not have a babysitter or if they just want to bring them along. The adolescent health staff will have someone available to entertain the children while the session is taking place.

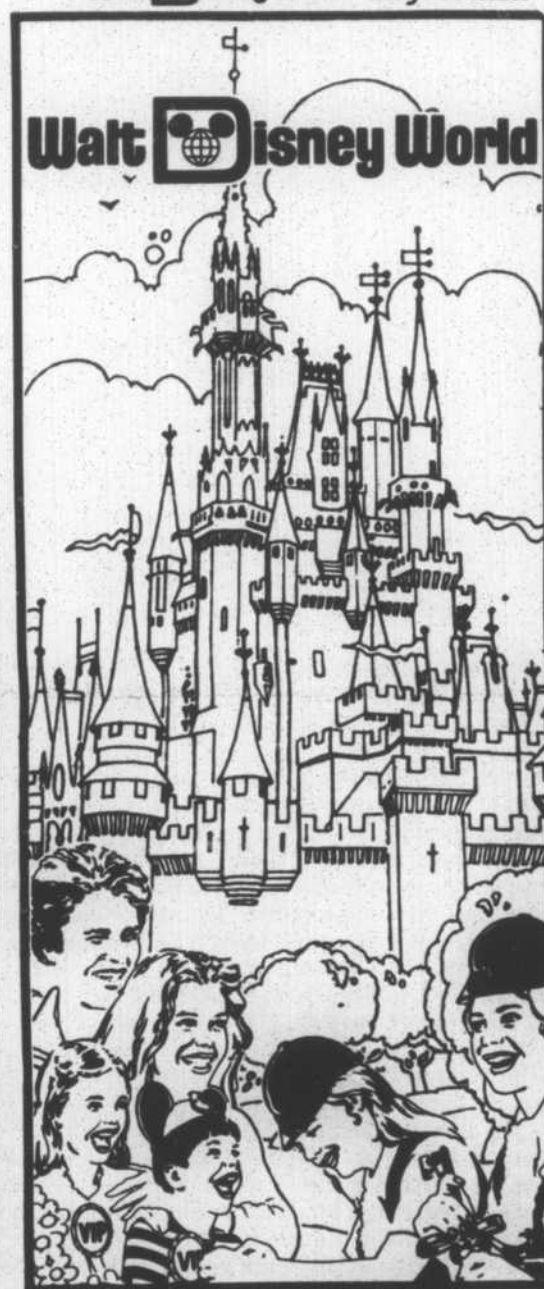
