CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL OF INDUSTRIAL PROJECT

(Interco Incorporated Project - Warren County) Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes S159C-7.

The undersigned, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE of the State of North Carolina (the "Secretary," pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and the Regulation prescribed by the Secretary thereunder, DOES HEREBY CERTIFY, FIND AND DETERMINE as follows:

(a) The Warren County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority," a political subdivision and body corporate and politic of the State of North Carolina created by resolution adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Warren, in accordance with Chapter 159C of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended (the "Act,")) has filed with the Secretary, pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the Act and the Regulations prescribed by the Secretary thereunder, an Application for Approval of its proposed industrial project described therein (the "Project") to be operated by Central Sportswear Co. (the "Operator," a wholly-owned subsidiary of Interco Incorporated. The Project is to be financed in part by an issue of approximately \$1,150,000 principal amount of revenue bonds of the Authority.

(b) The Project consists of the acquisition, construction and installation of manufacturing facilities in the Warren Industrial Park, Warren County, North Carolina, including land,

renovation of an existing building and machinery and equipment. The Project is estimated to cost approximately \$1,150,000 and will provide approximately 172 new jobs.

(c) Public Notice of the Authority's submission of its Application for Approval was duly published in the manner prescribed by the Regulations prescribed by the Secretary and all comments received in accordance with such notice has been considered by the Secretary.

Upon due consideration of the Authority's Application for Approval and the comments received with respect thereto, the Secretary hereby further CERTIFIES, FINDS AND DETERMINES as follows, pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the Act and the Regulations of the Secretary prescribed thereunder:

1. The Project is an Industrial Project for Industry.
2. Notwithstanding the fact the Operator of the Project does not pay an average weekly manufacturing wage which is above the average weekly manufacturing wage paid in Warren County or not less than 10% above the average weekly manufacturing wage paid in the State of North Carolina, the Board of Commissioners of Warren County has, by resolution, requested the Project be approved, and unemployment in Warren County is especially severe as defined in Section .0303(d) (2) (i) of NCAC Subchapter 1E.

3. The Project will not have a materially adverse effect on the environment.
4. The jobs generated by the Project will be large enough in number to have a measurable impact on the area immediately surrounding the location of the Project and are commensurate with the size and cost of the Project.
5. The Operator of the Project has demonstrated

its capability to operate the Project.
6. The financing of the Project by the Authority will not cause or result in the abandonment of an existing industrial or manufacturing facility of the Operator or an affiliate of the Operator elsewhere within the State of North Carolina.

7. The Project is hereby approved and this Certificate of Approval shall become effective as provided in Section 159C-7 of the Act.
