NOTICE OF INTENT TO ABANDON A LINE OF RAILROAD

Seaboard System Railroad, Inc. (SBD) hereby gives notice that on or about January 30, 1984, it intends to file with the Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, D. C. 20423, an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity permitting the abandonment of a portion of a line of railroad known as the Roanoke Rapids Subdivision, Raleigh Division, extending from railroad Milepost SA-85.80 near Roanoke Rapids, NC, to Milepost SA-114.77 near Norlina, NC, a distance of 28.97 miles, in Halifax and Warren Counties, North Carolina. The line SBD will seek to abandon includes the stations of Littleton (MP SA-98), Macon (MP SA-109) and Warren Plains (MP SA-113) which are served by a mobile agency based at Henderson, NC.

The reason for the proposed abandonment is to eliminate an unprofitable line and to avoid the maintenance expense on that line.

This line of railroad has appeared on the SBD system diagram map in Category 1 (Section 1152.10 (b) (1) since March 25, 1963, as segment 1-NC-7.

SBD is agreeable to imposition of The Oregon Short Line Conditions, Oregon Short Line R. Co.— Abandonment, Goshen, 360 ICC 91 (1979), for protection of the interests of railroad employees.

Any interested person, in response to this notice, is entitled to file with the Interstate Commerce Commission written comments in support of the proposed abandonment or protests to it.

Protests to the proposed abandonment shall at a minimum con-

tain:  
(1) Identification of protestant including its name, address, and business;

(2) Statement of protestant's interest in the abandonment proceeding; whether protestant uses the involved service; and if it does not, information with respect to the group or public interest it represents;

(3) Specific reason(s) for opposing the abandonment, including information with respect to protestant's reliance on the involved service with allegations of fact supported by an affidavit of personal knowledge of the facts;

(4) Any rebuttal of information or material submitted by applicant; and

(5) Request for oral hearing and reasons therefor if desired.

In addition, any commentator or protestant may provide a specific statement of position and summary of evidence with regard to any or all of the following:  
(1) Intent to offer financial assistance;  
(2) Environmental impact;  
(3) Impact on rural and community development;  
(4) Suitability of the properties for other public purposes; and  
(5) Recommended provisions for protection of the interests of employees.

Written comments and protests will be considered by the Commission in determining whether an investigation is needed to assist in determining what disposition to make of the application. In the event an investigation is conducted, then the commenting party or protestant may participate in the proceeding as its interest may appear.

Those parties filing protests to the proposed abandonment should be prepared to participate actively in either oral hearings or via the submission of additional material in the form of verified statements. Parties seeking information concerning the filing of protests should refer to 49 CFR 1152.25.

Written comments and protests should indicate the proceeding designation No. AB-55 (Sub-No. 89) and should be filed with the Secretary, Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, D. C. 20423, no later than February 29, 1984. Interested persons may file a written comment or protest with the Commission to become a party to this abandonment proceeding. A copy of each written comment or protest shall be served upon the representative of the applicant, Fred R. Birkholz, General Attorney, Seaboard System Railroad, Inc., 500 Water Street,

Jacksonville, Florida 32202 (904) 359-1248. The original and two copies of all comments or protests shall be filed with the Commission together with a certificate of service.

If no protests are received within 30 days after the application is filed, the Commission will grant the abandonment request and issue a certificate which permits the abandonment to occur within 75 days after the application is filed.

The line of railroad sought to be abandoned is available for subsidy or sale in accordance with applicable laws and regulations (49 U.S.C 10905 and 49 C.F.R. 1152.27). Applicant will promptly provide upon request to each interested party an and minimum purchase price required to keep the line in operation.
