

Judge Wilkinson Presides Over Warren District Court

Judge C. W. Wilkinson, Jr. of Oxford presided over the Sept. 5 session of Warren County District Court, disposing of the following cases:

Joyce P. Schuster, four counts of worthless checks, dismissed with leave by prosecutor.

Herman Junior Alston, failure to yield, dismissed by prosecutor.

Bobby Lee Wilson, driving while subject to an impairing substance, ordered to jail for two years, suspended for three years and defendant placed on probation for three years on condition he serve 14 days in the Warren County Jail, obtain an abuse assessment and pay the \$25 fee, complete the Alcohol and Drug Education Traffic School and pay the \$100 fee and pay a fine of \$250 and costs. He was also ordered to surrender his operator's license and not operate a motor vehicle until allowed to do so by the Department of Motor Vehicles. A charge of no driver's license was dismissed by the prosecutor.
