


## BLOCK **Block Helps** In Project

Nathan Block, Jr., son of Mrs. Marie Block of Warren County and the late Nathan (Joe) Block, recently accompanied the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration satellite from New Jersey to California. Block, who is employed at Goddard Space Flight Center (NASA) in Greenbelt, Md., was responsible for the spacecraft's vibration monitoring instrumentation, data acquiation, and data reduction during its transportafrom RCA tion Aerospace in New Jersev to Vandenberg Air Force Base in California.

The satellite was manufactured by RCA Aerospace in Hightstown, N. J. On Oct. 1, it was loaded on an airride truck and shipped to McQuire Air Force Base, N. J., and from there it was flown by military aircraft to Vandenberg Air Force Base. There it will undergo testing and preparation for launch, scheduled for Nov. 8.

Block has been employed by Goddard Space Flight Center for the past 16 years, and has received several awards for his accomplishments there.
