Track Obstruction Found At Norlina

A five-foot-high obstruction on the Seaboard Systems rudtood tracks in Norlinwas discovered Wedneslay morning just the foods prior to the passage of the firfacting from a cotag to a report by the Norlina Pelice Department

The barricade consisted of two large cable. spools, a small cable spool, a metal pipe, and a large piece of iron. which were stacked in the middle of the tracks The potentially dangerous blockage was reported to Norlina Police at 6 20 a m by a local resident, Richard Alexander, who discovered it as he walked past the tracks on his way to work

Sgt James M Champion went to investigate the site near a coal house just 250 feet from the Norlina police station. After removing the barricade from the racks, he could be under build so for comment of the books of the

While he relt it likely that the train would have knocked the barricade out of the way, he did not calle out the possibility of ferailment. The intent, he said, appeared to have been to cause a train decailment.
