Leaves Provide Clues To Many Plant Ailments

House plants have ways of telling you something isn't right, and a couple of these are yellowing of leaves and dropping leaves. Here is a check list from North Carolina State University agricultural extension specialists for trouble shooting plants showing symptoms:

—Improper light. This can be either too much or too little light, but most likely in the case of house plants it is a matter of insufficient natural light.

—Shock of transplanting. Moving the plant from one container to another may have been poorly done. Possibly the soil wasn't firmed around roots, or were a lot of the roots lost during transplanting?

—Sudden changes in temperature or light.

—Over - fertilization or, less frequently, under-fertilization.

—Drafty location.

—Gas fumes.

—Insects and diseases. Insects are fairly obvious, but diseases are more difficult to detect.

—Packed soil due to infrequent repotting and improper watering.

—Improper moisture. Too much water is a common problem.

The NCSU extension specialists say that yellowing or dropping of leaves from house plants or both, could be the result of any one or a combination of the above.
