

# Judge Allen Presides Over Session Of District Court

Judge Ben U. Allen of Henderson presided over the Nov. 13 session of Warren County District Court disposing of the following cases:

James Darryl Baylor, speeding 89 in 55 mph zone, called and failed, order of forfeiture issued, set for judgment absolute on bond on Jan. 8, 1986.

Jason Laverra Bridges, speeding 84 in 55 mph zone, called and failed, order of forfeiture issued, set for judgment absolute on bond on Jan. 8, 1986. Charges of driving while impaired and driving while license revoked were consolidated for judgment with the above charge.

Catherine W. Buttler, exceeding a safe speed, guilty, ordered to pay a fine of \$25 and court costs.

Ulysses Champ, speeding 55 in 35 mph zone, guilty, ordered to pay a fine of \$25 and court costs.

Danny Ray Davis, failure to dim headlights called and failed, order for arrest issued for defendant's appearance on Dec. 11. Bond set at \$100, secured.

Henry Louis Davis, carrying a concealed weapon, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for a period of 30 days, sentence suspended upon conditions that he pay a fine of \$10 and court costs, and that the confiscated weapon be turned over to the sheriff for disposal according to law. On a charge of driving while impaired, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for a period of 90 days, sentence suspended for one year upon following conditions: that he pay a fine of \$100 and court costs, pay \$100 to the clerk of court for the Sheriff's Undercover Fund, report to Virginia to complete its Alcohol & Drug Education Traffic School and pay the fee

directly to that facility. On a charge of possession of drug paraphernalia, not guilty; motion to quash warrant denied. On a charge of simple possession of marijuana, not guilty.

Andrew Lee Fogg, driving while license

revoked, called and failed; order for arrest for appearance on Dec.

11 issued. Bond set at \$1,000 secured. Order of forfeiture on bond. Charges of driving while

impaired and driving left of center consolidated

with the above charge for judgment.

Frank Guadagno, speeding 75 in 55 mph zone, guilty to speeding 70 in 55 mph zone, ordered to pay a fine of \$25 and court costs. A charge of no driver's license was dismissed by the prosecutor.

Juan Martine Guerrero, no driver's license, called and failed. Order for arrest returned unserved. Set for 90-day failure on Feb. 19, 1986.

Lee B. Hargrove, no driver's license, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for a period of 60 days; sentence suspended upon the condition that defendant pay a fine of \$100 and court costs. Charges of operating a motor vehicle without financial responsibility and displaying a fictitious card or tag were consolidated for judgment with the above charge.

Carol Scott Hill, speeding 69 in 55 mph zone, called and failed, reciprocal. Set for 90-day failure on Feb. 19, 1986.

Wallace Lindsey Howell, speeding 65 in 55 mph zone, called and failed, reciprocal. Set for 90-day failure on Feb. 19, 1986.

Roy Jones, communicating threats, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for a period of not less than 60 days nor more than 60 days. A charge of driving without a license was consolidated for judgment with the above charge.

Julius Kearney, driving while impaired, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for not less than nor more than 120 days; sentence suspended for two years and defendant placed on unsupervised probation for two years upon the following conditions: that he pay a fine of \$250 and court costs, complete 72 hours community service in 90 days and pay the \$50 fee; complete the Alcohol and Drug Education Traffic School and pay the \$50 fee; not operate a motor vehicle on the highways of N.C. for 90 days with no limited privilege license issued for that period. On a charge of no driver's license, not guilty.

David Wayne Marrow, simple possession of a Schedule VI controlled substance, guilty. Ordered to pay to clerk of court the sum of \$50 to be transferred to the Sheriff's Undercover Fund and pay the costs of court. On a charge of driving left of center, guilty, ordered confined in Warren County Jail for a period of 30 days, sentence suspended upon condition that he pay a fine of \$10 and court costs. On a charge of driving while impaired, not guilty. It appeared to the court from conversations with the assistant district attorney and defense counsel that a type of plea bargain had been struck which would necessitate a mistrial. Therefore it was ordered that a mistrial be declared and the trial on the charge to be continued to Jan. 15, 1986, the plea bargain being that defendant will plead guilty to DWI on that day.

Annie Collins McAdoo, speeding 72 in 55 zone, guilty to speeding 70 in 55 zone, ordered to pay a

fine and \$10 in court costs.

William McHenry McCann, speeding 70 in 55 zone, called and failed, reciprocal. Set for 90-day failure on Feb. 19, 1986.

Sean Douglas Mosley, speeding 70 in 55 zone, dismissed by prosecutor.

Charles L. Racine, Jr., reckless driving-endangering, not guilty; failure to heed light/siren, not guilty.

John Simpson, communicating threats, dismissed by prosecutor; assault and battery, dismissed by the prosecutor.

Sam Page Vereen, violation of court order. It appeared to the court that the defendant was in substantial compliance and order to show cause ordered dismissed.

Roy Jones, probation violation, court found that defendant had willfully and without

lawful excuse violated the conditions of the suspended sentence and ordered the sentence of two years in the custody of the N.C. Department of Correction go into immediate effect.
