

# Judge Ben U. Allen Presides Over District Court Session

Judge Ben U. Allen of Henderson presided over the Nov. 20 session of Warren County District Court, disposing of the following cases:

John Anderson, non-support of illegitimate child, court ordered case dismissed without prejudice. As to failure to appear, the defendant was ordered to jail for two days, sentence suspended upon condition that he pay a \$25 fine.

Robert Lee Bachtrope, no driver's license and endangering reckless driving, called and failed, arrest order issued, bond set at \$200.

Larry Boyd, assault and battery and assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury, court found as a fact that the defendant was incompetent to proceed with the trial of these charges and ordered that he be committed to John Umstead Hospital under House Bill 95.

Helena Cheek, communicating threats, ordered to jail for 30 days, sentence suspended for one year upon condition that the defendant not molest or bother or assault or threaten the prosecuting witness and pay the costs of court.

Ronnie Douglas Clay, no driver's license, called and failed.

George Cole, abandonment/non-support of child, ordered to jail for six months, sentence suspended for five years upon condition that the defendant pay into the office of the Clerk of Superior Court the sum of \$20 each and every week, court costs remitted.

Stacey Thompson Daniel, driving while impaired, ordered to jail for 90 days, sentence suspended and defendant placed on unsupervised probation for one year upon condition that he pay a \$100 fine and court costs, complete 24 hours community service within 30 days and pay the \$50 fee, complete the

Alcohol and Drug Education Traffic School and pay the \$50 fee and surrender license and not operate a motor vehicle on the highways of N.C. except as may be allowed in a limited driving privilege, allowed 30 days to comply.

William W. Ellington, assault and battery, ordered to jail for 30 days, sentence suspended for two years upon condition that the defendant not assault anybody and remain of good behavior, court costs remitted.

Plummer Falcon, Jr., injury to personal property, ordered to jail for 90 days, sentence suspended upon condition that the defendant pay into the office of the Clerk of Superior Court the sum of \$200 restitution for the use and benefit of Willoughby Harris, pay the costs of court and for two years remain off the premises of South Main Laundry.

Eddie Lewis Gilchrist, driving while impaired, ordered to jail for six months, sentence suspended and defendant placed on supervised probation for two years upon condition that he pay a \$400 fine and court costs, serve seven days active in jail, obtain an abuse assessment and pay the \$25 fee and surrender license and not operate a motor vehicle on the highways of N.C. for one year.

Elizabeth P. Harris, speeding 65 in 55 mph zone, found guilty of exceeding posted speed, ordered to pay a \$10 fine and court costs; defendant gave notice of appeal to the next criminal session of Warren County Superior Court.

Wilbert A. J. Hoff, speeding 70 in 55 mph zone, called and failed.

Jacob Jiggetts, trespassing without a license, called and failed, order of forfeiture and arrest order issued, bond set at \$200.

Charles Karsey, injury to personal property,

dismissed with leave by the prosecutor.

John Kearney, assault inflicting serious injury, ordered to jail for 30 days, sentence suspended upon condition that the defendant pay into the office of the Clerk of Superior Court the sum of \$150 restitution for the use and benefit of the prosecuting witness, pay a \$10 fine and court costs and not molest or bother the prosecuting witness.

James Carrey Lamb, speeding 68 in 55 mph zone, called and failed, arrest order outstanding.

Lenny Lynch, driving left of center, dismissed by the prosecutor; driving while impaired, ordered to jail for 90 days, sentence suspended and defendant placed on unsupervised probation for one year upon condition that he pay a \$100 fine and court costs, complete 24 hours of community service in 30 days and pay the \$50 fee, complete the Alcohol and Drug Education Traffic School and pay the \$50 fee and surrender license and not operate a motor vehicle on the highways of N.C. except as allowed in a limited driving privilege, allowed 30 days to comply.

Everett Leigh Mann, Jr., speeding 67 in 55 mph zone, found guilty of improper equipment, ordered to jail for five days, sentence suspended upon condition that the defendant pay a \$10 fine and court costs.

Calvin J. Mayfield, no driver's license, called and failed, arrest order outstanding.

Frank Lewis Mayo, driving left of center, dismissed by the prosecutor; driving while impaired, ordered to jail for six months, sentence suspended and defendant placed on unsupervised probation for two years upon condition that he

pay a \$250 fine and court costs, complete 72 hours of community service in 90 days and pay the \$50 fee, complete the Alcohol and Drug Education

Traffic School and pay the \$50 fee, surrender license and not operate a motor vehicle on the highways of N.C. except as allowed in a limited driving privilege and obtain an abuse assessment and pay the \$25 fee.

W. C. Miller, manufacture/creation of marijuana, entered a plea of guilty of misdemeanor possession of marijuana, ordered to jail for 30 days, sentence suspended for two years upon condition that the defendant not possess any controlled substance, pay a \$50 fine and court costs and pay \$100 for the Warren County Sheriff's Undercover Fund.

William Thomas Moore, no driver's license, called and failed, arrest order outstanding.

Sammy Lee Richardson, stop sign violation, called and failed, arrest order issued, bond set at \$100.

Thomas Solomon Rivers, no driver's license, called and failed, arrest order issued, bond set at \$200.

Joe David Silver, no driver's license, stop sign violation and expired registration card/tag, called and failed, arrest order issued, bond set at \$200.

Tony King Solomon, no driver's license, called and failed, arrest order issued, bond set at \$200.

James Henry Stewart, no driver's license, endangering reckless driving and driving while impaired, called and failed, arrest order outstanding.

James Hunter Sutton, assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury, court found as a fact that the defendant was incompetent to proceed with the trial in this case and ordered the defendant committed to John Umstead Hospital under House Bill 95.

Cassandra A. Terry, unsafe movement, dismissed by the prosecutor.

Alvin Turner, non-support of dependent child/spouse, it appearing to the court that the prosecuting witness had filed a statement with the Clerk of Superior Court stating that she did not wish to receive further support payments from the defendant through the Clerk's office, the portion of the judgment requiring child support payments was ordered stricken.

Brinda Williams, trespassing without a license, prayer for judgment continued upon condition that the defendant not go back on the premises of the prosecuting witness until she has the court's permission, ordered to pay court costs.

Joyce Williams, trespassing without a license, prayer for judgment continued for two years upon condition that she pay court costs and remain off the premises of the prosecuting witness.

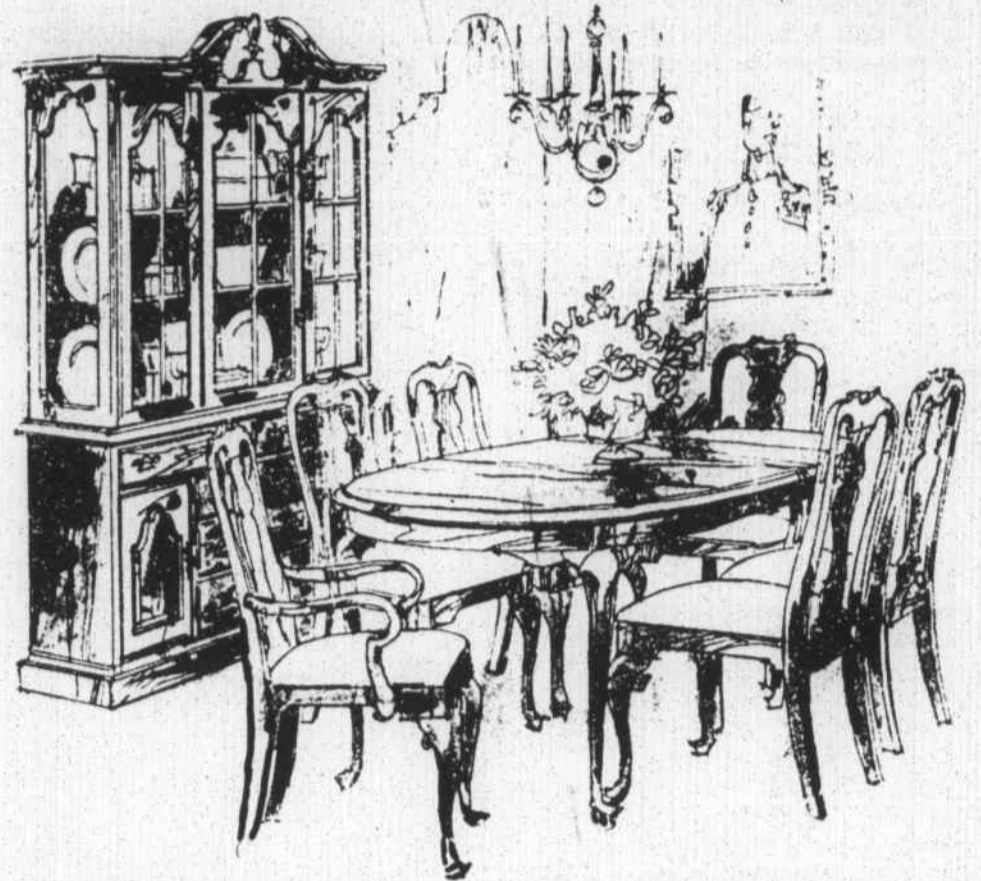
An absolute divorce was granted in the case of Wanda Gray Tolbert vs. James Andrew Tolbert, Jr.
