The WOW! Program will gradually be made available to all interested Warren County industries. Because of the extensive effort needed with both program implementation and follow-up, new employee work groups can be enrolled only once every three months. Currently financed by state and local funds, businesses and industries enrolling in the program will be asked to share the cost.

Mrs. Hilliard emphasized the benefit of this program to the whole county. "Although our primary target is the work force of large businesses and industries, all citizens will be able to take advantage of the education and support activities which will be available."
