All interested citizens are invited to attend.







NOTICE: 1990 TAX LISTING

The Machinery Act Of North Carolina provides in part: "It shall be the duty of every person, firm or corporation, in whose name any property is to be listed, to list said Real or Personal Property within the time prescribed by law. Any person, or corporation whose duty it shall be to list any property, who willfully fails, or refuses, or neglects, to list the same within the time prescribed by law, or removes or conceals property for the purpose of evading taxation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) or imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months. Failure to list shall be prima facie evidence the failure was willful." BE SURE TO LIST YOUR TAXES DURING THE PRESCRIBED TIME, WHICH IS THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1990.

ALL VEHICLES OWNED ON JANUARY 1, 1990, AND SITUATED IN WARREN COUNTY MUST BE LISTED. FAILURE TO LIST COULD RESULT IN A \$100 PENALTY PER VEHICLE.

ALL FARM AND BUSINESS FORMS MUST BE COM-PLETED IN DETAIL BEFORE THEY ARE RETURNED TO THE TAX ASSESSOR'S OFFICE.

It is the responsibility of the taxpayer to list any and all improvements to his property, and any improvements not recorded shall be deemed "discovered property" and taxed as such, together with all penalties as provided by law. (G.S. 105-312)

WE ENCOURAGE LISTING BY MAIL TO AVOID LONG LINES; however, if you have questions regarding your listing, you may contact the Tax Assessor by phone or in person. Office hours are from 8:30 a.m. through 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

THE TAX LISTING PERIOD FOR 1990 IS JANUARY 2, 1990, THROUGH JANUARY 31, 1990.
