## Agriculturally **Speaking**

Cold weather has arrived, and many potted plants are now being grown inside as house plants.

When you grow plants indoors, you need to provide a slow rate of growth. It is important to remember that environmental conditions, such as light and humidity, are low. To keep plants growing at a slower rate, fertilizer levels become extremely important.

In most cases, over fertilizing is the problem. Very seldom does under fertilizing exist. To help avoid over fertilizing, I suggest using a water soluble fertilizer on your house plants. Water soluble fertilizer comes as a dry powder or concentrated liquid and is mixed in water for dilution purposes.

Slow release and organic fertilizers are also good for house plants. Slow release fertilizers release nutrients slowly. This helps to prevent over fertilizing gives plants nutrients over a period of months. Organic fertilizers also release nutrients more slowly than water soluble fertilizers, however, some organic fertilizers have an odor which is objectionable for indoor use. It is important to note also that slow release and organic fertilizers are more expensive than water soluble fertilizers.

Again it is important to remember that you want plants to grow at a slow rate during the winter. Many plants begin a winter dormant period during which they require little or no fertilizer. Even plants which do not become dormant require little or no fertilizer. The greatest response to fertilizer growth.

Symptoms of over fertilizing can vary and depend on the particular nutrient involved. Symptoms can include stunting, leaf scorch, dead edges on leaves, leaf yellowing, reddening or purpling.
