**NEW RAILROAD WILL
SHORTEN DISTANCE**

(Special to The Sentinel)
SEATTLE, Wash., Nov. 21.—The new Grand Trunk Pacific across the continent through Canada and the British possessions, when completed, will shorten the distance between New York and Yokohama 1,500 miles over the San Francisco route, 500 over the Canadian Pacific route and fully as much over the Hill routes. The new line will pass through the great growing regions of Manitoba, Assinbia and Alberta for about 1,000 miles and will then enter the rich mineral regions of British Columbia. The Pacific terminal will be on the Skeena river where a city called Prince Rupert is being built. The road is being constructed with all possible dispatch.
